## GRANTS POLICY

### **Azelia Hall Community Grants – Summary for Applicants**

Azelia Hall offers grants to local organisations that support the well-being of residents in the London Borough of Bromley who are sick, convalescent, disabled or infirm. Our aim is to help improve quality of life, reduce isolation, and support activities that make a positive difference in the community.

Grants may be used to provide services, activities, goods or support that benefit qualifying residents. Individuals may benefit from grants, but only organisations can apply.

### **What We Fund**

We welcome applications from organisations whose work supports the following:

- Health and Well-Being Activities, services or practical support that help people who are sick, recovering, disabled or living with long-term conditions.
- Community Meetings, Classes and Support Sessions
- Inclusive meetings, workshops, lectures or classes that take place at or relate to Azelia Hall and benefit qualifying residents.
- Recreation and Social Activities
- Recreational or leisure-time activities that improve well-being, reduce loneliness, or help people feel more connected to their community.

All funded activity must clearly benefit residents who are sick, convalescent, disabled or infirm.

### **Who Can Apply**

- Only organisations (charities, CICs, community groups, clubs, voluntary bodies) operating within the London Borough of Bromley
- Organisations must show how their project will benefit qualifying residents
- Individuals cannot apply directly, but may benefit from funded activities

## **How to Apply**

Applications must be submitted using the online application form available on the Azelia Hall website.

The website also includes FAQs to help guide you through the process.

You will be asked to provide:

- A description of your project or activity
- Who it will benefit and how
- A clear budget
- Any supporting information requested by the Trustees

Applicants may be invited to meet with Trustees or provide further information.

Please note: Trustees are not able to enter into correspondence about decisions, and applicants are not entitled to an explanation if a grant is declined.

## **How Decisions Are Made**

Trustees assess applications based on:

- How well the project supports the charitable purpose
- The benefit to qualifying residents
- Value for money and feasibility
- Inclusivity and accessibility
- Overall impact on well-being and quality of life

Grants may be one-off or ongoing, depending on need and available funds.

## **After a Grant Is Awarded**

Organisations receiving a grant will be asked to provide:

- Updates on progress
- Evidence of how funds were used
- A short report on outcomes achieved

This helps us ensure that grants continue to make a meaningful difference.
